CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No.AAPANA. 2091/CR-2773/37/Jal-6.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of Government Notification, Rural Development, No. GWC. 3774/(221)XVI, dated 17th July 1976 and of all existing rules, orders or instruments made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules for regulating recruitment to the post of Director in the Maharashtra Ground Water Service, Class-I, under the Rural Development and Water Conservation Department of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Director in the Maharashtra Ground Water Service (Recruitment) Rules, 1993.

2. In these rules unless the context requires otherwise,—

- (a) " Commission " means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission ;
- (b) " Government " means the Government of Maharashtra ;
- (c) " Degree " means a degree of Statutory University.

3. Appointment to the post of Director in the Maharashtra Ground Water Service, shall be made either,—

(A) by promotion of a suitable person on the basis of strict selection from amongst the person holding the post of Joint Director in the Maharashtra Ground Water Service and possessing the qualifications prescribed for appointment by nomination in sub-clause (ii) and (iii) of clause (C) of this rule ; or

(B) by transfer,—

(i) of a suitable officer holding an equivalent post in any department of the Government and possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination in sub-clauses (ii) (iii) of clause (C) of this rule ; or

(ii) on deputation of a suitable officer holding an equivalent post under Government or in any other State Government or Central Government or in a Corporation owned or controlled by the Central Government or State Government and possessing the qualifications and experience prescribed for appointment by nomination in sub-clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (C) of this rule ; or

(C) by nomination from amongst candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 45 years of age ;

No. AAPANA. 2091/CR-2773/37/Jal-6.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution of India the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules to amend the recruitment rules for the post of Director, in the Maharashtra Groundwater Service, Class-I (Recruitment) Rules, 1993.

1. These rules may be called the Director in the Maharashtra Groundwater Service, Class-I (Recruitment)(Amendment) Rules, 1993.
2. In the Maharashtra Groundwater Service, Class-I (Recruitment) Rules, 1993 in rule 3(c)(iii)(a) for the words "systematic hydrogeological surveys in igneous sedimentary and metamorphic terrains;" the words "carrying out systematic hydrogeological surveys in igneous sedimentary and metamorphic terrains;" shall be substituted.

REGISTRATION ACT, 1908.

No. RGN. 1093/1470/CR. No. 360/M-1.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d) of sub-section (1) of section 88 of the Registration Act, 1908 (XVI of 1908), in its application to the State of Maharashtra, the Government of Maharashtra, hereby specifies for the purposes of the said section 88, the holders, for the time being, of the office of the Regional Officers of the Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation at Thane and Latur.

(ii) possess a post-graduate degree in Geology or Applied Geology of a statutory University or any other qualification of an Indian or a foreign institution recognised as equivalent thereto by the Government for the purpose of these rules; and—

(iii) possess practical experience gained after acquiring the qualifications mentioned in sub-clause (ii) above in the field of—

(a) Systematic hydrogeological surveys in igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic terrains;

(b) groundwater exploration and assessment by drilling and testing; and—

(c) processing interpretation of field data and in preparing and editing technical reports and the like.

for a total period of fifteen years out of which at least eight years' administrative experience shall be in a responsible capacity:

Provided that, preference may be given to candidates, who—

(i) possess experience in planning and implementation of ground water survey and development programme (including knowledge of various types of drilling and testing equipment used in exploration and development) in a responsible capacity; or

(ii) have published research papers in any branch of geology or hydrogeology;

Provided further that the age limit may be relaxed in favour of candidates with exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

4. The person appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. The person appointed to the post whether by promotion, transfer or nomination shall be required to pass examination in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing, those examinations.
