CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. AAPANA. 1189/CR-2034/37.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the post of the Joint Director (Class-I) in the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency of the Government of Maharashtra, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Joint Director (Class-I) in the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency (Recruitment) Rules, 1991;

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) " Commission " means the Maharashtra Public Service Commission ;

(b) " degree " means a degree of a Statutory University ;

(c) " Directorate " means the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency ;

(d) " Government " means the Government of Maharashtra.

3. Appointment to the post of Joint Director in the Directorate shall be made either,—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person, on the basis of seniority subject to fitness, from amongst the persons holding the post of Deputy Director in the Directorate for a continuous period of not less than three years and possessing the qualifications mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of clause (b) or

(b) by nomination from amongst the candidates who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 45 years of age ;

(ii) possess a Master's degree in Geology or Applied Geology or hold a diploma in Applied Geology of the Indian School of Mines, Dhanbad or any qualifications recognised by Government to be equivalent thereto, and

(iii) possess practical experience in—

(a) carrying out Systematic Hydrogeological Surveys in Igneous, Sedimentary and Metamorphic Terrains.

(b) groundwater exploration and assessment by drilling and testing, and

(c) processing and interpretation of field data and in preparing and editing technical reports

for a period of not less than twelve years, gained after acquiring the qualifications mentioned in sub-clause (i), out of which not less than five years must be in organising, supervising and guiding field units.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (i) of clause (b) of rule 3, the age limit may be relaxed by Government on the recommendation of the Commission in favour of candidates possessing exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

5. Appointment to the post by promotion and nomination shall be made in the ratio of 50 : 50.

6. A person appointed to the post by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

7. A person appointed, whether by promotion, or nomination shall be required to pass the examinations in Hindi or Marathi in accordance with the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing such examination.

8. A person appointed to the post shall be liable for transfer to any place in the State of Maharashtra.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. AAPANA. 1189/CR-2034/37.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor Maharashtra hereby makes the following rules to amend the Joint Director (Class-I) in the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency (Recruitment) Rules, 1991 as follows, viz :—

1. These rules may be called the Joint Director (Class-I) (of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1991.

2. In rule 3 of the Joint Director (Class-I) in the Directorate of Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency (Recruitment) Rules, 1991,—

In clause (a) instead of the words "seniority subject to fitness," the words "selection," shall be inserted.

In rule 3 (b) (iii) after the words "possess practical experience," the words "gained after acquiring the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) above" may be inserted.

In rule 4, before the word age, the word 'upper' shall be inserted.
