#### CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. GWO. 3774/(218)-XVI.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is, hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating the recruitment to the posts of Senior Geologist, Geologist, and Senior Hydrologist in the Maharashtra Ground-Water Service Class I and Assistant Geologist in the Maharashtra Ground-Water Service Class II, namely:—

#### RULES

1. These rules may be called the Senior Geologist, Geologist, and Senior Hydrologist in the Maharashtra Ground-water (Service Class I) and Assistant Geologist in the Maharashtra Ground-water (Service Class II) Recruitment Rules, 1976.

#### I. Senior Geologist

Appointment to the post of Senior Geologist in the Maharashtra Ground-water (Service I) shall be made, either—

(a) by promotion of a suitable Geologist in the Ground-water Surveys and Develop Agency with at least three years service as such to his credit; or

(b) by nomination from among candidates, who—

(i) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra, are not more than 45 years of age;

(ii) possess a post-graduate degree in Geology or Applied Geology of a recognised University or the diploma in Geology or Applied Geology from the Indian School of Mines, Dhanbad or any other recognised equivalent qualification; and thereafter

(iii) have practical experience in hydrogeological work, comprising of regional hydrogeological surveys in sedimentary, metamorphic and volcanic terrains, exploratory drilling and testing of aquifers; and problems related to well hydraulics, for a period of seven years (five years in the case of candidates with a first class post-graduate degree or diploma);

Provided that preference may be given to those who in addition:—

(i) have previous experience in a responsible capacity in any institution doing field work in hydrogeology and who have carried out or supervised independent field mapping, prospecting and surveying; or

(ii) have published papers in any branch of Geology or Applied Geology; or

(iii) have secured a Doctorate in Geology or Applied Geology with practical experience of Hydrogeological field work.

Provided further that the age limit may be relaxed in the case of those having exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

2. The appointment shall be made by nomination and by promotion in the ratio of 1:1.

3) A candidate appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

4. A person appointed to the post whether by promotion or by nomination shall be required to pass the Departmental examination and examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the prescribed rules, unless he has already passed them or has been exempted from passing them.

II. Geologist

5. Appointment to the post of Geologist shall be made, either—

(a) by promotion of a suitable Assistant Geologist in the Ground-water Surveys and Development Agency with at least three years service as such to his credit; or

(b) by nomination from among candidates, who—

(i) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra, are not more than 40 years of age;

(i) possess a post-graduate degree in Geology or Applied Geology or a recognised University by the State Government or the diploma in Geology or Applied Geology from the Indian School of Mines, Dhanbad or any other recognised equivalent qualifications and thereafter.

(ii) have practical experience in hydrogeological work comprising of regional hydrogeological surveys in sedimentary, metamorphic, and volcanic terrains, exploratory drilling and testing of aquifers and problems related to well hydraulics, for a period of five years, (three years in the case of candidates with a first class post-graduate degree or diploma).

Provided that performance may be given to those who—

(a) have previous experience in a responsible capacity in any institution doing field work in hydrogeology and who have carried out or supervised independent field mapping, prospecting and surveying and

(b) have published papers in a branch of Geology or possess a Doctorate in Geology or Applied Geology;

Provided further that the age limit may be relaxed in the case of those having exceptional qualifications or experience, or both.

6. The appointment shall be made by nomination and by promotion in the ratio of 1:1.

7. A candidate appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

8. A person appointed to the post whether by promotion or by nomination shall be required to pass the Departmental Examination and Examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the prescribed rules, unless he has already passed them or has been exempted from passing them.

### III. Senior Hydrologist

Appointment to the post of Senior Hydrologist shall be made either—

(a) by promotion from among the Assistant Hydrologist in the Ground-water Surveys and Development Agency who possess the qualifications prescribed for appointment by nomination; or

(b) by transfer of an Executive Engineer from Irrigation Department, possessing the qualifications prescribed for appointment by nomination; or

(c) by nomination from among candidates who—

(i) unless, already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra, are not more than 45 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree in Civil Engineering of a recognised University by the State Government on an equivalent qualification; and thereafter

(iii) should have practical experience of at least five years of undertaking, on systematic and scientific basis, hydrological surveys for exploration, assessment, conservation and development of ground-water resources.



Provided that preference may be given to a candidate possessing qualifications in Hydrology or Hydrogeology and/or training in Hydrological surveys;

Provided further that the age limit will be relaxed in favour of candidates possessing exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

9. A candidate appointed by nomination will be on probation for a period of two years.

10. A person appointed to the post shall be required to pass the Departmental examination and examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the prescribed rules, unless he has already passed them or has been exempted from passing them.

11. A candidate holding an Engineering degree shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service or post connected with the Defence of India, any where in India or abroad, for a period of not less than four years including the period spent on training, if any, on such condition as are determined by the Government of India.

Provided that such person shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment.

Provided further that such person shall not ordinarily be required to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of 40 years.

IV. Assistant Geologist

12. Appointment to the post of Assistant Geologist shall be made either—

- (a) by promotion of a suitable Geological Assistant in the Ground-water Surveys and Development Agency with not less than 3 years' service as such to his credit; or
- (b) by nomination from among candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra, are not more than 35 years of age; and

(ii) possess a post-graduate degree in Geology or Applied Geology of a recognised University, by the State Government, or diploma in Geology or Applied Geology of the Indian School of Mines, Dhanbad or any other recognised equivalent qualifications.

Provided that preference may be given to candidates who possess previous practical experience of field work in Hydrogeology or have published papers in any branch of the subject.

Provided further that the age limit may be relaxed in the case of candidates with exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

13. The appointment shall be made by nomination and by promotion in the ratio of 1:1.

14. A candidate appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

15. A person appointed to the post whether by promotion or by nomination shall be required to pass the Departmental examination and examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the prescribed rules, unless he has already passed them or has been exempted from passing them.

3. In the First proviso after paragraph '5' the word "performance" shall be read as "preference".
4. In the 2nd Line of paragraph 8 (c)(ii) the word, 'on', shall be read as word 'or'.
5. The first paragraph of the recruitment rules for the Sr. Hydrologist shall be numbered as '9' and the subsequent paragraphs in the succeeding order.
