

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to sub-rule (2) of rule 166 of the Bombay Motor Vehicles Rules, 1959, the Government of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to exempt the said vehicles from the operation of the provisions of the said sub-rule (2) of rule 166, subject to the condition that (i) the rear overhang of each vehicle does not exceed 52.8 per cent and (ii) the vehicles are used only for the carriage of scooters.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. GWO 2273/(222)-XVI.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all previous rules or orders or any instrument made in this behalf, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules regulating recruitment to the posts of Deputy Directors in the Maharashtra Groundwater Service, Class I; namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Directors in the Maharashtra Groundwater Service, Class-I, (Recruitment) Rules, 1976.

2. In these rules, unless the context requires otherwise,—

- (a) "Government" means the Government of Maharashtra;
- (b) "Recognised University" means a University duly established by law and recognised by Government for the purposes of these rules.

3. (1) Appointment to the post of a Deputy Director in the Maharashtra Groundwater Service, Class I, shall be made either,

(a) by promotion from amongst Senior Geologists, in the Groundwater Surveys and Development Agency of Government, possessing the qualifications mentioned in sub-clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (c) of this sub-rule;

(b) by transfer of a suitable officer from the Department of Geology and Mining of Government;

(c) by nomination from amongst the candidates, who,—

(i) unless already in the service of Government are not more than 45 years of age on the first day of the month in which the post is advertised, and

(ii) possess a post-graduate degree in geology or Applied Geology of a recognised University or Diploma in Applied Geology of the Indian School of Mines, Dhanbad, or any qualifications recognised by Government to be equivalent thereto, and

(iii) have practical experience in the field of (a) carrying out systematic hydro-geological surveys in igneous sedimentary and metamorphic terrains (b) groundwater exploration and assessment by drilling and testing and (c) processing, interpretation of field data and in preparing and editing technical reports, for a total period of ten years out of which three years' experience shall be in organising, supervising and guiding field units.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clause (i) of clause (c) of sub-rule (1), the upper age limit may be relaxed in the case of candidates with exceptional qualifications or experience or both.

3. Appointments by promotion and by nomination shall be made in the ratio of 1 : 1.

4. A candidate appointed by nomination shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. A candidate appointed, whether by promotion, transfer or nomination shall be required to pass the departmental examination and examinations in Hindi and Marathi in accordance with the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed, or has been exempted from passing such examinations.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. EST. 1385/1626/CR-957/37.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Deputy Directors in the Maharashtra Groundwater Service, Class I, (Recruitment) Rules, 1976, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Directors in the Maharashtra Groundwater Service, Class I, (Recruitment) (Amendment) Rules, 1987.

2. In the Deputy Directors in the Maharashtra Groundwater Service Class I, (Recruitment) Rules, 1976, in rule 3, in sub-rule (1),—

(a) in clause (a), for the words "sub-clauses (ii) and (iii) of clause (c)" the words "sub-clause (ii) of clause (c)" shall be substituted;

(b) in clause (c), in sub-clause (iii), after the words "have practical experience", the words "gained after acquiring the qualifications prescribed in sub-clause (ii) above" shall be inserted.
