Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to sub-rule (1) of rule 211 of the Bombay Motor Vehicles Rules, 1959, the Government of Maharashtra hereby exempts the said vehicle from the operation of the provisions of sub-rule (1) of the said rule 183, subject to the condition that (i) the vehicle is fitted with an electrical or mechanical signalling device, and (ii) the vehicle complies with the provisions of rule 169 of the Bombay Motor Vehicles Rules, 1959.

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CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

✓ No. (GWO, 3774/(220)/XVI) In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the previous rules or orders made in that behalf and in force in the State or any part thereof the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following recruitment rules regulating recruitment to the posts of ~~Administrative Officer (Class I) and Assistant Administrative Officer (Class II)~~ in the Directorate of Ground Water Survey and Development Agency, Maharashtra State, Pune, namely:—

1. These rules may be called the Administrative Officer (Class I) and Assistant Administrative Officer (Class II) (of Ground Water Survey and Development Agency) Recruitment Rules, 1976.

2. In these rules unless the context requires otherwise,—

(a) "Directorate" means the Directorate of Ground Water Survey and Development Agency of the State of Maharashtra, Pune;

(b) "Recognised University" means a university which has been recognised by the State Government for the purposes of these rules.

3. Appointment to the post of Administrative Officer, Class I, shall be made either—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person from the cadre of Assistant Administrative Officer in the Directorate who has worked for not less than three years in that post and also possessing the qualification mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of clause (c) or

(b) by transfer of a suitable Class I Officer from any department or office of the Government of Maharashtra who has worked as such for at least five years and possesses the qualifications mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of clause (c) or



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(c) by nomination from amongst candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra, are not more than 35 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree in Arts, Science, Commerce, Law or Agriculture of a recognised University or an equivalent qualification and thereafter;

(iii) possess experience in a responsible administrative capacity in any department or office of the Government of Maharashtra or a local body or industrial or commercial undertaking for not less than five years.

Provided that, the age limit may be relaxed in favour of candidates who possess exceptional qualification or experience or both:

Provided further that preference may be given to candidates who possess (i) a post-graduate degree of a recognised University or (ii) experience in administrative work relating to a large industrial or commercial establishment and in organisation and method work.

4. Appointment to the post of Assistant Administrative Officer, in the Directorate may be made either—

(a) by promotion of a suitable person from amongst Superintendents in the Directorate who has worked for not less than three years in such post:

Provided that, Assistant Superintendents, who have worked for not less than five years in that post, may be considered if a suitable person from the Superintendents cadre is not available.

(b) by transfer of a suitable Class II Officer from any Department or Office of the Government of Maharashtra, who has worked as such for at least 3 years and possesses the qualifications mentioned in sub-clause (ii) of clause (c) below, or.

(c) by nomination from amongst candidates who—

(i) unless already in the service of the Government of Maharashtra, are not more than 35 years of age;

(ii) possess a degree in Arts, Science, Commerce, Law or Agriculture of a recognised University or an equivalent qualification and thereafter;

(iii) possess experience in supervisory capacity in any department or office of the Government of Maharashtra, Local body or industrial or commercial undertaking for not less than three years.

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed in favour of candidates who possess exceptional qualification or experience or both:

Provided further that preference may be given to candidates who possess (i) a post-graduate degree of a recognised university or (ii) experience in administrative work relating to a large industrial or commercial establishment and in organisation and method work.

5. Candidates appointed to the posts referred to in rules 3 and 4 by nomination shall be on probation for a period of one year.
